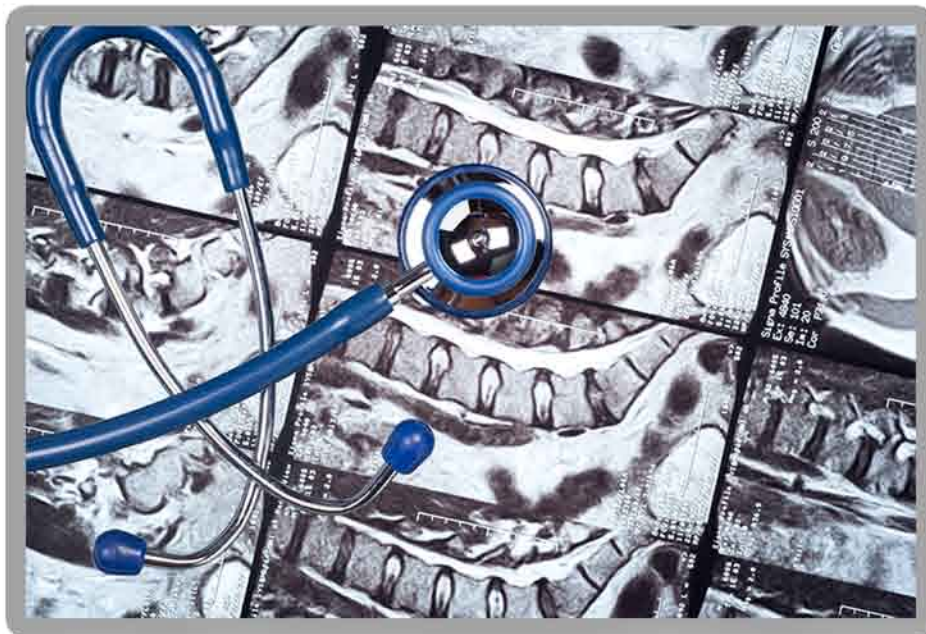


Medical Imaging and the Big Data Future
