Forensic Computing involves the examination of digital devices in order to recover evidence of criminal activity. To find out more about the MSc in Forensic Computing, come along to our Open Day on the 29th June 2015.

You will visit the Centre for Forensic Computing, which is based at our Shrivenham campus in Oxfordshire (situated at the Defence Academy of the UK). The Centre is engaged in Education, Research and Casework in digital forensics.
